

## Discussing sustainability and education for sustainable development

### ABSTRACT

The ESDEUS project (European Universities as Community Leaders of the Education for Sustainable Development) is a partnership between four European countries (coordinated by the DSW University of Lower Silesia, Poland). We focus on the meaning of sustainability and Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) in different dimensions. We analyse national and regional/local policies on sustainable development and try to understand forms of cooperation between higher education institutions and community stakeholders in the field of ESD (among other activities).

In this webinar we want to have a dialogue on sustainability and sustainable development and the role, potential and limitations of ESD within it. We have invited different stakeholders of the project - institutions from the community as well as colleagues from higher education. Although at the beginning of the dialogue we will encourage these stakeholders to come forward, all participants are welcome to contribute to the debate.
